## **Types of Glue**

	Good For	Not Good For	Brands (with links)
Polyvinyl Acetate (PVA)	Wood	Joints with gaps	Elmer's, Titebond Original
Hide Glue	Antiques	Joints with gaps	<u>Old Brown,</u> <u>Titebond Hide Glue</u>
Ероху	Joints with gaps	Antiques	<u>West System,</u> <u>J-B Weld</u>
Fish Glue	Long assembly time	Joints with gaps	Lee Valley Tools
Polyurethane	Outdoor use	Joints with gaps	Gorilla Glue

Proper glue procedure for PVA and Hide Glue includes ALL four of these requirements:

- 1. Tight joints
- 2. Clean joints
- 3. Glue applied to all surfaces of both parts (use an artist's brush)
- 4. Clamping Pressure
